OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME:

- To increase awareness among the public regarding the causes and consequences of road accidents.
- To ensure that individuals have a clear understanding of traffic rules and regulations.
- To promote positive changes in behaviour and attitudes towards road safety.
- To decrease the number of road accidents and associated casualties.
- To promote adherence to traffic laws and regulations through education and awareness

REPORT OF THE PROGRAMME:

The Road Safety Awareness Program, jointly organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and National Service Scheme (NSS), aimed at promoting awareness about road accidents and traffic rules. Dr. Y. Rajasekar, Principal as President, played a key role in orchestrating the event, with Uma Maheshwara Rao, SI of Police, Punganur gracing the occasion as the esteemed Chief Guest delivered an insightful lecture shedding light on the societal impact of road accidents. His talk focused on the role individuals play in creating safer road environments and the need for collective efforts in minimizing road accidents. Finally, the programme concluded with vote of thanks proposed by M. Muniraja III B. Sc MSCs followed by national anthem. After the meeting a rally with about 105 students, staff and local people was conducted from the college to the centre of the town raising slogans that create awareness about traffic rules. Thus the programme ended on a satisfactory note.

OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAMME:

Students learned that

- Improved compliance with traffic laws, resulting in safer road behaviour and reduced risk of accidents.
- Individuals adopt safer driving practices, such as wearing seat belts, avoiding distractions, and following speed limits.
- Increased community engagement, with individuals and local organizations taking initiatives to address road safety issues in their neighbourhoods.
- Over time, the program helps instil a lasting culture of responsibility, resulting in sustained improvements in road safety practices
