Student Satisfaction Survey

2019-20

Student satisfaction survey for the year 2019-20 was conducted in the institution and collected the data manually. The following is the analysis of the responses received from the students which helps to improve the quality in teaching, learning and evaluation. For this purpose a questionnaire was given to hundred students of all programs and courses from 1st, 2nd and 3rd years which comprises of 20 questions and the students were encouraged to answer the questions on a 5point rating scale ranging from 1 to 5 where 1 stands for poor, 2 for average, 3 for good, 4 for very good and 5 for excellent.

A majority of the students affirmed that the teachers are excellent in covering the syllabus effectively and create interest among the students while teaching in the classroom and encouraging the students to participate in field visits and invited lectures and are encouraging to give seminars and to participate in extra-curricular activities.

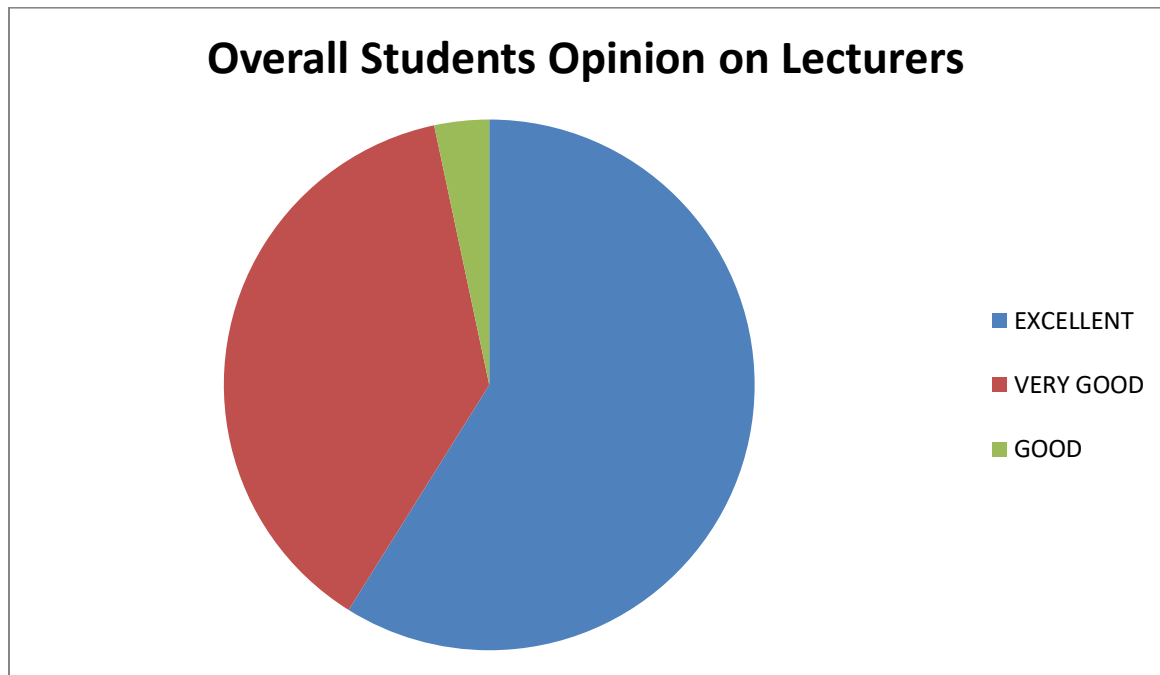
More than half of the students opined that the teachers are excellent in clarity of expression, the depth of the subject content, latest developments in the subject, use of class seminars and participative learning, encouraging to question and clearing their doubts, use of teaching aids, supervision of the projects, encourage to use Library and internet, conducting exams and valuing answer scripts, punctuality and regularity to class and carrier guidance and personal care as excellent.

A good number of students expressed that the clarity of expression of the teacher, the depth of the subject, participative learning, use of teaching aids, seriousness and regularity in valuing answer scripts, remedial coaching, personal care and affection of the students as very good.

A few students opinioned that the coverage of the syllabus, use of teaching aids, encouragement for study projects, clarity of expression and depth of content, accessibility of the teacher outside the class room, regularity and punctuality to class, personal care and affection towards students as good.

A very few students replied that the coverage of the syllabus, encouraging questions in the class rooms, guiding the students to give class seminars and participation in extra-curricular activities, personal care and helping the individual students as average.

53% of the students expressed the overall opinion on a lecturer as **Excellent** and 34% of the students opine as **Very Good** and only 3% of students felt that the overall opinion on a lecturer as **Good**.
